Hope is the greatest gift The Bridge To Life gives to the mothers who come to us. Our founder, Eleanor Ruder, started Bridge to Life in 1992 to serve single mothers.

Since then, we have welcomed over 3,500 women and children annually for counseling and material assistance.

Bridge is member of a Pregnancy Service Network whose common goal is to save the life of the baby by providing the mother with life-affirming options which include parenting or adoption.

Under no circumstances, do we refer women for abortions. The sidewalk counselors outside a Queens abortion center, from the Helpers of God's Precious Infants, refer women they counsel to us.

During counseling, we discuss the woman's support systems, offer her maternity clothes and refer her for supportive services. These include the recently opened New Beginnings Center of Hope. This is a Queens medical



pregnancy center, and it offers no-cost sonograms and parenting classes.

Upon the baby's birth and a social worker's referral, Bridge provides quarterly aid through our Material Assistance Program.

Our 24-hour hotline enables callers to talk to a trained coach about their pregnancies.

We've helped women who were homeless, abandoned by their families, victims of domestic violence and/or who were unemployed.

Governor Andrew Cuomo is the most pro-abortion governor in recent history. His support for the recently enacted RHA Act may become the reason for his excommunication from the Catholic Church.

Outside of our Executive Director, Catherine Black, and a part-time administrator, everyone connected to Bridge volunteers their time. We run on in-kind and monetary donations. We are grateful to all who support us and our dedicated volunteers, including many young adults.

Bridge's challenge is reaching the women who need us. You can help. Like us on social media and invite your friends to do the same.

Challenges Ahead in New York State

Greetings with appreciation for your work to promote and protect the God-given gift of Life.



The 2019 Session of the New York State Legislature opened January 9 with much fanfare and media accolades over the change of leadership in the State Senate from a slim pro-life control to a new 39-24 pro-abortion Democrat majority pledging to quickly enact a "progressive" agenda and "break down barriers."

In this more hostile political environment, we are mindful of the increased threats to the most vulnerable among us, but all pro-lifers must rise up in prayer and action in opposition.

While the previous years of pro-abortion rhetoric from Governor Andrew Cuomo has been searing and the battle difficult, prior to last November's elections, the unborn yet had a voice with the state Senate Republican leadership. The former Senate majority held off radical legislation continually by just one vote, due also to undaunted efforts by pro-lifers.

Governor Cuomo, now beginning his third term, is continuing his quest with the abortion industry to erase protections for the unborn and their mothers, expand late-term abortion past 24 weeks, prohibit common-sense legislation and pursue lines of attack against the life-saving efforts of pro-lifers.

The new one-party government in New York has a long "to-do" list, but the one agenda item on which the Governor and new Legislature is monolithically focused to pass, without discussion, is the so-called Reproductive Health Act which they vow to pass on January 22, the anniversary of *Roe v. Wade*.

RHA is being sold on outright lies by the abortion lobby, parroted by the media, that the bill merely "codifies" *Roe*, and "updates" New York's "outdated" laws.

These claims are false.

RHA would mandate abortion-on-demand without restriction, up until birth, and even after birth--(if a child is born during the course of an abortion, it would erase born-alive protections already in New York State law.)

RHA would establish abortion as a "fundamental right" in New York (something that *Roe v. Wade* did not do.) If abortion is made a fundamental right in New York State, expect pro-life viewpoint suppression, mandated participation by all health-care providers and further restrictions on pro-life efforts to save children's lives.

RHA would also allow **any** health-care practitioner to perform an abortion if the practitioner acts in "good faith" (rather than an objective medical standard of care). And it would remove protections for women and unborn children from illegal abortion. In short, the radical Reproductive Health Act is about enabling the abortion industry to operate without regulation, reservation, or regard for human life, mother's or child's.

Just as the Federal "Freedom of Choice Act" was defeated in the 1990's despite Democrats holding both Congress and the presidency, this abortion expansion in New York can also be defeated, if the public understands how radical it is. It is the 4th quarter of the game on this bill and the clock is ticking, but we must press on.

But that is not all. Already this year, other bills of concern are popping up, such as one that would require pro-life organizations to not "discriminate" based on an employee's or applicant's "reproductive health decision-making." Translation: Pro-life organizations could be forced to retain or hire employees not aligned with their views!

Another bill endorses the idea that hospitals can have policies in place that allow the hospitals to refuse the life-saving directives by an ill patient's health-care proxy.



Fatherhood

I thought I might save the following thoughts for next June, for Father's Day, but then I realized that they might well suffer the fate of that day. When Father's Day is over, it is over. And the message is one I think is desperately needed.

It comes from Bishop Thomas J. Olmstead of Phoenix. The Bishop is a very faithful, thoughtful witness to the calamity of our time—the widespread existence of fatherlessness.

His message is contained in an article called "*Into the Breach*," an Apostolic Exhortation to the Catholic men of his diocese. It is a message I've learned from my own father, the fathers of my friends, neighbors, acquaintances and classmates. A lesson was brought home by my experience at an abortion "clinic" here in Queens. This message, this experience, is profoundly foundational.

I was praying with a group in front of an abortion facility in Forest Hills. I'd been doing this for several years, and I've watched as husbands, boyfriends, and others brought women to the facility to have abortions. Indeed, even some mothers brought their daughters there to have abortions. And, in a particularly disturbing turn of events, I once saw a man who already had several children with the woman he brought there for an abortion.

On one particular day, a man brought his girlfriend there and remained "double parked" outside the clinic. One of our counselors who would talk with the women coming to have abortions, approached the man in the vehicle, who had bowed his head over the steering wheel with his face covered by his hands.

"Do you want this abortion?" asked the counselor. The man replied, "No, but I can't tell her what to do with her body."



For me, that moment is indelible. I remembered that my own father put his life and the lives of my brothers, my sister, and my mother before his own life. He was ready to give his life for me. And then I realized that this was what defined a father—and also what defined a man.

I do believe that without this sense of ultimate responsibility, there can be no happiness for a man—no self-respect, no manliness.

Bishop Olmstead says that all men are called to fatherhood, regardless of their state in life. He says that, "I offer this Exhortation as an encouragement, a challenge, and a calling forth to mission for every willing man in the Diocese of Phoenix: priests and deacons, husbands, fathers and sons, grandfathers and widowers, young men in preparation for your vocation—that is, *each and every man*."

The Bishop continues, "Every man, particularly today, must come to a mature acceptance and understanding of what it means to be a man. . . . looking at what the secular world holds up as 'manly' is in fact to look at shadows—or even outright counterfeits—of masculinity."

I hope to write more about Bishop Olmstead's message, but for now I would simply put forth his understanding of fatherhood and its role in our lives. He begins by saying that ***fatherhood changes history—all men are called to fatherhood in some way***. He notes that fatherhood had really not been stressed in the past because it was assumed that we understand it, but that this no longer true.

And, frankly, this matches up with other things which we think we understand but, in fact, no longer do, such as the idea of fairness, or the idea of a hospital, which both have their origin and continued meaning only in a Christian setting.

Bishop Olmstead's letter gives us three types of understanding about fatherhood which he calls the three masculine loves: as Friend, as Husband, and as Father.

Whatever his particular calling, however, "Every man is called to live as a husband *in some way*." ♦

Pro-Life On the Street

The winter 2018 edition of *Respect Life News* presented two articles discussing public actions on the streets of pro-life people, groups and organizations.

The first was "Telling a Pro-Life Story," by Madeleine Santangelo-Palumbo, which took place at All Women's Pavilion on Austin Street, Forest Hills.

Two mothers decided not to abort their babies but to keep them instead. The article told of the events leading up to and following their decisions.

The second article, "Two Sides of the Issue," by Frank Drollinger, discussed pro-choice and pro-life sides. The pro-life side was exemplified by the "March for Life, Washington, D.C." which occurs annually on or near the anniversary of *Roe v. Wade*.

Two more examples will be cited here. On the local level, activity in Steamboat Springs, Colorado, occurs at Planned Parenthood. The Knights of Columbus and parishioners at Holy Name Catholic Church pray and witness twice every month throughout the year.

Also, a few years ago, 50 crosses were placed on the Church lawn to represent **50 million babies aborted as of that date!**

Of even wider impact is "40 Days for Life." What started out as a one-time local effort in 2003 in College Station, Texas, grew rapidly, nationally and internationally.

"40 Days for Life" campaigns twice a year in the spring and fall. The spring campaign coincides with Lent starting on Ash Wednesday and ending on Palm Sunday. The 2018 spring campaign started on Ash Wednesday, February 14, in 354 cities across 25 countries.

As of the report of April 13, 2018, **645 babies have been saved during this campaign. Since 2007, “. . . 14,643 babies’ lives have been saved, 177 abortion workers have quit, and 96 abortion sites have been closed as a result of the work of "40 Days for Life."**

If you log into their web site: www.40DaysforLife.com, you can create a log-in to receive e-mail updates daily during campaigns and at various other times. ♦

Editorial Comment: To be sure, "40 Days for Life" is a very much commendable organization for its truly wonderful pro-life work. It assuredly earns support from all. 

STATEMENT ON THE so-called “REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH ACT” SIGNED INTO LAW BY GOVERNOR CUOMO

Governor rightly refers to new law as “the most aggressive” abortion law in the country

New York State Right to Life (NYSRTL) is saddened that New York now has what Governor Andrew Cuomo ironically but rightly referred to as “the most aggressive” abortion law in the country. The Reproductive Health Act (RHA) was sold to the public saying it merely “updates” the law by codifying *Roe vs. Wade* into our statute, which is not true. RHA has made abortion a “fundamental right” and prohibits all limits on abortion, which *Roe vs Wade* did not do. *Roe* referred to a trimester view toward protecting life, whereas RHA has expanded abortion-on-demand in New York past 24 weeks - well past when unborn children feel pain, are viable, and suffer during the course of an abortion – and up to birth. This is inhumane. While we look forward to the time when *Roe vs Wade* is overturned, under *Roe* various limits on abortion have repeatedly been upheld as constitutional and are favored by the majority of the public, including in New York. The Governor routinely calls people of good will concerned with how we treat human life extreme, whereas it’s this new law that is truly extreme. NYSRTL will continue to work to expose the misinformation put forth about RHA, protect children and their mothers, protect the rights of pro-life persons to engage in life-saving activities and express their views, and to build a culture of Life in New York.

Memo of Opposition to the “Reproductive Health Act,” S.2796 (Krueger) / A.1748 (Glick)

NYSRTL opposes the so-called “Reproductive Health Act” (RHA). If enacted, RHA would not only lead to an increase in the number of abortions, but expose New York mothers to increased dangers by removing protections currently in New York statute. *Supporters of RHA claim it merely seeks to update New York’s laws to make them consistent with Roe v. Wade. This claim is false.* The changes this bill would make instead would authorize abortion through all nine months, for any reason, with no restrictions, up until birth, and even after birth if a child is born during the course of an abortion (i.e. infanticide). The few protections in New York law should not be repealed. Abortion is not health care.

RHA would establish abortion as a fundamental right in New York.

If abortion is elevated to a fundamental right, emanating from such right would be restrictions on communications deemed to impede a woman’s decision-making about an abortion (pro-life viewpoint suppression), mandated participation by providers that object, and further restrictions on pro-life efforts to save children’s lives. Also, any reasonable restriction on abortion – *including laws the Supreme Court has already upheld under “Roe” as constitutional* – would be precluded. RHA instead declares, “It is the intent of the legislature to prevent the enforcement of laws or regulations... that burden abortion access.”

RHA would authorize abortion up until the moment of birth.

Currently, late term unborn children are protected in New York State law after 24 weeks except to save a mother’s life. RHA would repeal that standard and exchange it for a “health” exception, broadly interpreted by courts to include age, economic, social and emotional factors, rather than the biological definition of “health” that normally comes to mind. Late term unborn children are capable of pain and suffering and should be saved from death.

RHA would allow any health care practitioner to perform an abortion.

Current law states only a duly licensed physician may perform an abortion. RHA would allow any licensed health care practitioner to perform an abortion if the practitioner acts in “good faith” (rather than an objective medical standard of care), opening the door broadly for abuse.

RHA would remove protections for women and unborn children from illegal abortion.

RHA would repeal New York’s Penal Law to remove the criminal act of abortion, preventing prosecution of illegal abortions, including those performed by any self-proclaimed provider, or ones resulting from intentional violence committed against a pregnant mom and her child. This is the *opposite* of pro-woman. Abortion is a tragedy, even more so resulting from interpersonal violence. Illegal abortion should remain on the books to allow prosecution in these cases.

RHA would repeal protective medical standards for mother and child.

The law requiring certain abortions to take place in hospitals on in-patient basis would be repealed. Also, the law requiring a second physician after twenty weeks to attend to any infant born alive to provide medical care would be repealed (in effect, endorsing infanticide).

RHA is about enabling the abortion industry to operate without regulation, reservation or regard for human life.
